

DAY 10 CRAFT – MAKE A MINI NORTH POLE MAILBOX





What Kids Will Make

A tiny red-and-white North Pole Mailbox that opens and closes and fits their Santa letter (or wishes, drawings, jokes, Turbo notes!).



Materials

- 1 toilet roll **or** small cardboard box
- Red paper (or colour it!)
- White paper for stripes
- Glue stick or tape
- Scissors


Stickers, markers, glitter (optional)




STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

(kid-friendly)

1. Wrap the Mail box : Cover the toilet roll (or box) in red paper OR colour it completely red.
2. Add the candy cane stripes : Cut thin white strips and glue them around the top and bottom.
3. Create the lid : Cut a small half-circle from white card. Glue it to the top edge. (so it looks like the little flip-lid on old mailboxes).
4. Attach the mail flag : Cut a tiny rectangle from red card, glue it to the side like a real postbox signal.
5. Add the North Pole signs : Use the printable sheet



- **“North Pole Mail” label**
- **Little snowflakes**
- **Turbo footprints**
- **Candy canes**
- **Mini stars**



Let the kids decorate as they like.

Post their Santa letter.

Kids fold their Day 9 letter and post it into their brand new mini mailbox.
